

Instructions

To make your own Magic Pencil bookmark, follow these four easy steps:

1. Colour in the pencil with your own special design.
2. Carefully cut out the pencil along the dotted lines (don't cut close to the edge of the drawing yet!).
3. Glue to a piece of card – a piece of cereal packet would be fine.
4. When the glue is dry, cut carefully around the edge of the pencil.
5. If you like, cover in sticky-back plastic (the kind used to protect books). Or, for a really professional look, use a laminating machine (ask your teacher very nicely or go to the local copy shop!).
